**All-aluminum 'built' small-blocks are not permitted. No small-block engine can surpass 450 cubic inches.*

Tires:

Right-Rear: American Racer 48 or 53 (any track or series stamp)

Left-Rear: American Racer 44 ONLY (any track or series stamp)

Fronts: American Racer 33 or harder (any track or series stamp)

**Standard chain-link Modified tires only; no block-tread tires; no 49 compound American Racers*

Day Motor Sports will ONLY have fronts, left-rear 44 and right-rear 48 available. Contact Day Motor Sports at 800.543.6238 for tire information.

Body Rules:

Standard bodies only; no sail panels or other deviations per STSS rules and procedures.

Qualifying:

Drivers will draw to determine heat-race starting positions. Draws take place at the Short Track Super Series trailer in public view during the pre-race drivers' meeting. Drivers must register their cars prior to the start of the drivers' meeting for inclusion in the draw. The feature event starting field of will be filled by qualified cars from heat races and consolations as needed. Two STSS Cajun Region provisionals (*full pay*) will be available to the two highest Cajun Region competitors in the 2021 final point standings unable to qualify.

Race Procedures:

Only green-flag laps will count in the 40-lap feature event. Restarts are double file through lap 34. The leader can choose inside or outside after the completion of one lap. At lap 35, restarts are single file. Lapped cars drop to the rear in the order they are running at the time of a caution. The first car off the lead lap at the time of the caution will be waved around past the leader via the 'Lap-Down, Go-Around' program.

All heat-race and consolation restarts will be double file. Heat races and consolations are 10 laps.

AMB transponders are required for this event.

One-way radios are mandatory. The frequency is 454.000.
